PRESCRIBED WASTE FEE CALCULATION FORM

pursuant to regulation 11 of the *Environment Protection (Fees) Regulations 2001*

Instructions for completing this form

1. This form only applies to the prescribed industrial waste received at the premises. Annual licence fees for discharges to the atmosphere, water and land will be calculated and charged separately.
2. Pursuant to regulation 11 of the *Environment Protection (Fees) Regulations 2001*, the annual licence fee is 0.103 fee units for each tonne of prescribed industrial waste received by the premises in a year. One fee unit currently equals \$12.22.
3. Pursuant to section 24(2A) of the *Environment Protection Act 1970*, the fee for a prescribed waste licence is not to exceed \$513,240.
4. Pursuant to regulation 14 of the *Environment Protection (Fees) Regulations 2001* an accredited licensee under the Act is entitled to a 25 per cent reduction of the annual licence fee otherwise payable.
5. The Environment Protection Levy pursuant to section 24A of the *Environment Protection Act 1970* applies to all prescribed waste licences and is to be charged at the rate of three per cent of the licence fee payable.
6. This statement must be certified by CEOs, company directors/secretaries or other authorised officers. A contact name and phone number should also be supplied.
7. All calculations are to be rounded to two (2) decimal places. Rounding down to whole numbers may result in the Authority requiring an additional payment.
8. The completed form must be forwarded to your regional EPA office by 30 September.
9. Once EPA has verified your calculations an invoice will be forwarded to you payable by 30 November.
10. Late payments incur penalties under the *Penalty Interest Rates Act 1983*. The Authority may reject improperly completed forms and any accompanying payment which may then generate a liability for penalty interest if the completed form is received after the due date.
