WHO IS SEITA?

SEITA is the abbreviated name given to the Southern and Eastern Integrated Transport Authority (SEITA).

SEITA was established by the state government of Victoria to facilitate the development of the Mitcham Frankston Freeway (EastLink).

SEITA can provide information on the history, planning requirements and decision making behind the building of EastLink.

WHAT IS SEITA'S ROLE IN EASTLINK?

SEITA will look after the interests of the state throughout the delivery of this Private Public Partnership to build and operate EastLink.

In addition to overseeing the construction and delivery of the project, SEITA has statutory planning control for EastLink in accordance with the Mitcham Frankston Project Act 2004. This planning control cedes all other planning control.
