If you're using a woodfire heater, you have a duty to reduce the smoke it produces.

If you use a wood heater you have a duty to reduce the amount of smoke it produces.

Simply follow these steps to reduce smoke pollution from your heater:

- always burn with a flame - don't let your fire smoulder
- after reloading, open the air control and burn your fire on high for 20 minutes, especially before going to bed
- only burn dry, seasoned wood
